
Prime Agricultural Soils

Worthington's prime agricultural soils are located on the plateau region of the eastern half of town. This area is the most developed due to the existing infrastructure, the minimal slope, and these good soils, which more easily allow placement of septic systems.

Worthington's agricultural soils are ideal for growing hay, potatoes, and bush fruits. These lands constitute 10 percent of Worthington.


