Stay Safe – You can vote by mail for both elections

STATE PRIMARY – Tuesday, September 1, 2020

GENERAL ELECTION – Tuesday, November 3, 2020

Vote-By-Mail Options

Saturday, August 22, 2020: Last day to register & change party enrollment for the Primary

Wednesday, August 26, 2020: Last day to apply for a Vote by Mail ballot for the State Primary

Saturday, October 24, 2020: Last day to register for the General Election

Mail-in Voter Registration forms available on counter at Worthington Post Office

By now, you should have received your vote-by-mail application from the State.

Polls open 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. Mailed ballots due by close of polls.
