This Weekend: Participate in the Great Backyard Bird Count

Join me and other bird enthusiasts worldwide this Friday through Monday, February 14 through 17, for the Great Backyard Bird Count (GBBC). More than a half-million people participated during the 2024 GBBC—more than double the number that participated just five years ago. They reported 7,920 species of birds from 200+ countries and subregions. The GBBC helps scientists learn about the distribution and abundance of birds. Simply report the number of individuals of each species you see during a single counting session, and submit your counts through

eBird or the Merlin Bird ID app. Visit GBBC's how-to-participate page to learn more.

From the Nurse's Office:

So much **sickness** here! A record 22 out of 75 students (almost 30%!) were out one day last week, and even some teachers. 25% of students were out on Tuesday, but we are averaging 18% absent for these last three days.

And such a **long recovery time** for the flu! I would like to add another measure of your child's readiness to return to school after illness in addition to no fever for 24 hours without fever reducers: we need fuel to carry us through the day, so make

sure your student has been able to **eat a full supper the night before they return**, especially if they eat breakfast at school, and you don't know whether they'll eat or not.
