And give you the same service for, instead of four something a month, it's 260 a month.

It's a little less than half.

I mean, it's a little more than half, so it saves about 40%.

The access plus connection is symmetrical fiber, so with whatever you have up, you've got the same thing down, versus Comcast, which is not symmetrical, because once it gets in the building, it's coaxed.

And your download speed may be gig, but I have gig plus at 1.2, but it's only 40 up versus 1.2 gigabyte down, 40 megabyte down, anyway that's one of the reasons that Access Plus is superior because it's for upload and it's faster, which may help with your data.

All right anyway so that's ongoing, I'll probably go ahead and sign the contract, I got a double check with Peggy and then and if you guys want to take a look at it it's fine too but there's no reason not to do it if I can see.

To travel 50 feet, to say \$10 ,000 to travel 50 feet, that sounds about right.

No, but I don't think you need three-phase power for a 50-amp charger, that's all I'm saying.

I don't know.

I don't need three-phase or my home charge, but it's possible that Selectboard Office is almost maxed out, too.

So, this is not so much of a work plan than just a task list, almost out of my head, but I don't know if we want to go through each item, but basically it goes to what I would be willing to do in terms of looking at the previous study.

Looking at alternates in terms of siting and construction type and working with these guys, working with you on the site selection, what's happening with what I'm going to call it the preferred site and how to expedite that with the means coming in and chatting with you guys and chatting with real estate folks and lawyers.

I would do that and then report on a two-week or monthly basis just trying to keep it going.

17:53 - 18:14

Selectboard Office

So, kind of as a point person between these tasks, the original study and the idea that we'd locate to another site in a much more conservative budget, so I think a lot of gathering information towards, I'm going to call it a ballpark number.

Selectboard Office

Could be gathered without hiring a cost estimator or hiring contractor, which would cost us more, to get a grip on what the intent is locally and then go on to the next step.

Selectboard Office

So I know the Kiter and Bright Builders each have pre-construction studies, which would do this, but I think we should get to a point where we have a grip on a rough budget and then go to them, because if any contractor or cost estimator is going to be management, and management of management, and profit.

And stuff.

Selectboard Office

Rough budget for the construction, you mean?

For the whole thing.

So we've got to anticipate the purchase of the site and what that's going to take, and

legal expenses of getting, we're going to call it the preferred site, done.

And then it just triggers from there.

At the same time, I think we've each looked at industrial buildings in the six-figure category rather than the seven figure category.

So I think those companies would give us nests on their shell, even insulated and so on and so on.

The foundation has custom things for the wash bay.

And I think we could even source that locally in terms of an excavator concrete company.

Just to get a grip on it and then let pros.

Add contingencies and things like that.

But just to get to a point where we've identified a site and identified a building type that will work.

So in this list is visiting with real and going to sites that he knows or other ones that we recommend and maybe looking at industrial buildings, whatever.

The walkthrough with him is so productive in terms of imagining turning radiuses and things like that, but I think the knowledge base is there to get what's called a concept design level done.

So I think the first step would be meeting with you guys or whoever's gonna be leading the project from your side to talk about the site acquisition.

And meanwhile, meet with these guys in terms of the building parameters.

But the assumption would be a flat site, relatively flat site.

So I've made a little bit of headway with the Elbert's property, speaking of sites.

I spoke with Kathy from DEP, and so the issue is, is that after the cleanup there was never a phase two assessment, so never any resampling to see if there was any contamination left.

And so in the DEP roles, that site is still open in terms of a contamination site.

So it's pretty straightforward to do resampling and all that, but I think it would probably cost somewhere around \$50 ,000 to do the resampling.

Dep can help us.

There are other places that can help us.

There are certainly some.

But I think really what it would ultimately be would be to kind of resample the sample sites that they removed some of the barrels and whatnot from and had found

contaminant pits in the previous study.

Dep had a meeting today they are going to actually assign somebody to this to help and liaison with me because the woman I talked to was not a person that necessarily was going to be assigned.

So there is there's EPA funding but I didn't see anything that was open.

For the state there is brownfield funding but the brownfield issue is is what they want to do is they'll they'll do it but they want to try to recover their costs through getting the property back on the tax rolls and so the state sorry and so so for for some of the grants under Those state brownfield sites.

Municipal buildings are exempt from their funding.
